

CHAPEL SERVICES are open to all College members and staff, their guests and friends. All who wish to do so, whatever their tradition or denomination, are warmly invited to attend. The Book of Common Prayer (traditional language) is used for College Prayers on Sundays. Modern liturgies are used at other services.

COLLECTIONS taken during College Prayers support the work of a nominated charity. This term the money raised will go to support the work of the Oxford Food Bank.

CATHOLIC MASS will be celebrated on Tuesday of 6th week, at 6pm in chapel (the usual day and time of the College Eucharist).

Ascension Day

Thursday of 5th week is Ascension Day. There will be a Eucharist at 8am in chapel. Later in the morning we will welcome members of the congregations of some local churches into college as they 'beat their bounds', or check the integrity of their parish boundaries. This involves hitting walls with sticks, and is an interesting spectator sport.
