Ascension Day falls on 5 May (Thursday of week 3). In the morning the College will be visited by parishioners of St Mary the Virgin and St Michael at the North Gate for the traditional Beating of the Parish Bounds. Confirmation Service. The Bishop of Dorchester will visit the College on 17 May (Tuesday of week 4) to celebrate, preach and confirm at the College Eucharist at 6.00 pm.

The annual **Joint Service with Lincoln** takes place on the Feast of Corpus Christi, 29 May (Sunday of week 7). The service begins with a procession from BNC Chapel at 5.30 pm, followed by Evensong and Benediction in Lincoln Chapel. The preacher is the Visitor of both Colleges, the Bishop of Lincoln.

The **Platnauer Concert** takes place on Friday 13 May at 6.00 pm. The Oxford based string quartet OXUS specialise in contemporary music, and strive to present unusual repertoire by stripping away the formality that chamber music performance can involve. The concert will feature the monumental 'Different Trains' for tape and string quartet, by the great American minimalist composer Steve Reich. The concert is free and open to all College members. Drinks will follow in the Medieval Kitchen for those who attend the concert.

Roman Catholic Mass will take the place of the College Eucharist on Tuesday of week 7.

Theological Minds, the chapel discussion group, will meet in Heb. I on Friday of weeks 2 and 4 from 5.45 - 7.00 pm. Drinks and nibbles will be provided. All are welcome.
