

## MICHAEL WOODS TRAVEL GRANTS

Travel grants in memory of Michael Woods will be awarded to successful applicants at the end of Hilary Term each year. These are open to all Junior Members (undergraduates and graduates) of the College currently in residence and will be made to assist the applicant to undertake some travel during one of the vacations in the next twelve months. The travel should have some intellectually constructive purpose, though it is envisaged that the fulfilment of this purpose would also be, typically, something enjoyable and refreshing. The travel should not be for the purpose of pursuing one's academic course. Nor should it involve working for a charitable organization.

Those who wish to apply for one of these grants should give a reasonably detailed account of their travel project, with an estimate of the total cost and an indication of the degree of assistance they would require from the Fund. They should indicate how the proposed travel fits in with other activities, for instance, paid employment and academic work. Applicants should also state what difference the award of the grant will make to their plans. The Committee has up to £600 at its disposal in any one year.

Applications should be sent to the College Secretary by the end of the <u>SIXTH WEEK</u> of <u>HILARY TERM (Friday 26th February 2010)</u>.
