

If you are interested in joining our thriving **Chapel Choir**, please contact me (details below). The choir and organists provide an eclectic and challenging range of music for Evensong or Eucharist services each Sunday with occasional special services, concerts and choir tours abroad. The choir is currently non-auditioning and meets to rehearse each Thursday at 7pm - 8.15pm, and again on Sunday from 4.15pm - 5.45pm.

**Practice rooms** are available in College. There are two practice rooms available in the Frewin complex. These are available without booking and a key can be obtained from the Porter's Lodge. It is also possible to book practice time in the Chapel with initial permission from the Director of Music or Chaplain. The college owns a beautiful new Kawai **grand piano**, located in the antechapel. The piano is available to all those of proven pianistic ability with the permission of the Director of Music or Chaplain. A list of those with permission is kept at the Porter's Lodge and a key is required to gain access. Those using the piano must ensure that the instrument is properly closed, locked and that the key cover and body cover are replaced at the conclusion of each practice. With the exception of music in use, nothing is to be placed on the body of the piano. A revised booking system for chapel piano practice is likely to be implemented over the coming term, with a sign-in/sign-out book for the key maintained at the Porter's Lodge.

Concert opportunities are available to all those wishing to perform on an instrument or in an ensemble. If you would like to be involved in a concert, or need some help locating other musicians or collaborators, then I'd be delighted to help in any way that I can. Please get in touch!
