The legendary Italian concert pianist Victor Sangiorgio brings his internationally celebrated pianism to Brasenose in a recital of works by Haydn, Scarlatti, Chopin, and Chick Corea. With a focus on under-celebrated and contemporary works, Victor's career has been unusually varied. He has performed at major concert halls across the world with regular professorial invitations to major conservatoires. His acclaimed recordings of masterworks by Liszt, Glazunov, Mendelssohn, Stravinsky, Rachmaninov, Cimarosa, and many others, have been widely celebrated.
