Easy & discrete service – self-taken swab for women / urine test for men

Please follow instructions carefully. Chlamydia is common, easily spread, can be serious but easy to test for and treat. It also can be invisible:- About 70% of females and 50% of males will have no obvious signs or symptoms of chlamydia.
